1. **Introductions:** Alen Saric opened the meeting and welcomed everyone. Introductions were made.
2. **Minutes:** Doug Fuss made a motion to approve the November 9, 2016 meeting minutes. Bob Waitkevitch seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.
3. **Review Night Life Issues/Calls for Service/License for January and February renewals (sent with the agenda):**

Lt. Cashman reviewed the calls for service in the packet for both months

  - When asked, Lt. Cashman confirmed that there has been a decrease in calls for service at Bill's Pizza since more food options are available after bars have closed.
  - Perhaps Five Guys might benefit from more police presence as their crowds have increased
  - Oasis Liquor Law and Admin Violation was done on a bar check. Lt. Cashman will look into what type of violation it was and bring the info next month.
  - Casco Bay Lines "Bay Mist" – 99% of the recorded calls were for Casco Bay Lines, only 2 were for the Bay Mist. Special Attention Check = foot patrol or officers out of their cars.

**Oscar Pizza LLC d/b/a Otto. Application for a Class I FSE License at 576 Congress Street.** Application filed on 12/22/2016. Applicant holds a current Class III and Class IV License. They are upgrading to include spirituous.

6. **Other business:**
  - Alen has noticed lots of window breakage incidents in the Old Port. Lt. Cashman has not seen any activity regarding these incidents at the police department.
  - Information sharing: Legal recreational marijuana usage law is going into effect at the end of January.
    - A 6-month moratorium is in place for retail operations in Portland
    - It is only legal to smoke it in private clubs and retail establishments
    - Bob asked Lt. Cashman to share any info that he gets
    - The City wants to keep edibles in separate quarters than other food. Jessica will have details as the City starts licensing.
