



## **NLOC Meeting**

July 24, 2019 3:00 – 4:00PM

Portland Downtown – 549 Congress Street

**Minute 1. Welcome:** Sarah Martin opened the meeting, welcomed everyone present and asked for introductions. All present introduced themselves.

**Minute 2.** Review and acceptance of May 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting minutes. Josh Miranda made a motion and Kim Farrar seconded.

**Minute 3. Review Night Life Issues/Calls for Service/License for August and September 2019 renewals:** Lt. Hondo reviewed the calls for service in the packet. Comments/discussion:

- Committee members asked Lt. Hondo to provide detail on the Bonfire calls. Specifically, the assaults and fake IDs. Lt. Hondo responded that assaults were outside of the premise and that fake ID calls were resolved by PPD responding and verifying.
- A question was asked about the Fraud call for El Rayo. Lt. Hondo looked at the detail for the report and confirmed that it was pertaining to a motor vehicle burglary and that an arrest resulted from the call.
- 100 Commercial Street received a lot of calls due to transient encampments.

**Minute 4. Review of new and pending liquor licenses for August:** Jessica Hanscombe reviewed the applications that will go before City Council on August 12, 2019.

- Maps is changing ownership.
  - A committee member asked for clarification on the license – is it liquor or beer/wine? Jessica Hanscombe replied that it is just beer/wine.
- Congress Street Bar & Grill is changing ownership.

### **Minute 5. Other business**

- Josh Miranda noted that a business on Exchange Street is having gatherings that is drawing individuals who are smoking, urinating in public, fights/assaults, and generally disturbing the public. Lt. Hondo will put in a special attention check for the address. Josh also noted that, on First Friday, there is usually a skateboard ramp that blocks Exchange Street.
  - He also wanted to note illegal parking on Fox Court where there are no parking/tow away zone signs. Lt. Hondo will also add that to the special attention check.
- Mike Erickson let the committee know that he complimented the Old Port Bouncers forum at the Portland Downtown board meeting and commented that he feels it is well-run. The committee discussed the group, which has a closed Facebook group, and how it operates. Doug said that it is nice that it is organic, but that perhaps Portland Downtown would consider creating a Facebook page with a similar goal.
- Sarah Martin indicated that committee goals would be discussed at the next meeting.
- Kim Farrar asked what the past goals for the committee were and if they were met/achieved.

- Sarah Martin replied that some of the goals are not achieved because they are ongoing.
- Those present discussed more ideas for what a closed Facebook page for NLOC might be useful for.
