Our east coast city is easy to get to know and love. For starters, it's **WALKABLE**. Our cobblestone sidewalks aren't just for looks and charm; these historic streets are made for walking. With award-winning chefs, vibrant art exhibits, nautical tours, quirky storefronts, and whatever else your heart desires all just steps away, go ahead and put downtown Portland's walkways to good use. As you stroll through our downtown neighborhoods marveling at the historic architecture, popping into seatown shops, and fishing for the best lobster roll in town, take comfort knowing the salty shore is only ever a few blocks away.

If walking doesn't fit your lifestyle, no problem. Hop on a METRO bus, private trolley, or transit tour to help get you where you're going.

Have we mentioned our **WORKING WATERFRONT?**

Portland is located on a peninsula in Casco Bay. Its seaside setting makes whale watching, boat tours, and island excursions a breeze, and no doubt contributes to its summertime population growth. This small city of 68,000 — Maine's largest city and U.S. News and World Report's No. 1 "Best place to live on the East Coast" — is visited by 5.4 million each year.

Portland stands as one of few working waterfronts left countrywide, and there's a reason this seatown is known for its fresh-off-the-boat lobster. It annually scores as one of New England's top sea and fishing ports, reeling in some 108 million pounds of lobster in 2021 alone. So tuck that napkin into your shirt collar

and get ready for some mouthwatering eats, because Portland is for **FOODIES**.

Lobster may be an iconic New England staple, but there's plenty of other fish in the sea, including bites that aren't found in the Atlantic at all. Bon Appétit's "Restaurant City of the Year" in 2018 for its dining diversity, Portland is home to nationally-recognized chefs serving quite the mix of casual and fine-dining cuisines.
